PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a '**[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC]**' and to secure to all its citizens :

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity and to promote among them all;

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ²[unity and integrity of the Nation];

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949 do **HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.**

About The School

The school is divided into five sections

- **Nursery School** - Play Group - Preparatory
- **Junior School** - Class I - V (Co-Education)
- **Middle School** - VI - VIII Boys
- **Senior Secondary Section** - IX - XII Boys
- **Qadiria Girls Section** - VI - XII

HOUSES

The school is divided into four houses i.e. Cosmos, Lily, Rose and Tulip. This division provides opportunities for a better organizational set-up and for healthy competition in sports, academics and other activities among students. Every house has its house uniform which is worn on every Saturday and also whenever required.

MONITORIAL SYSTEM

The monitorial system is an important feature of the school. Students showing administrative and leadership qualities are chosen as monitors. This is an honour and at the same time a means of stimulating an attitude of responsibility and initiative. It also serves as a channel of communication between the staff and the students.

DISCIPLINE

Discipline and good conduct are the basic requirements of a good student. We teach our students to maintain the decorum of the institution. Any breach of rules, or use of abusive language or indecent behaviour that is likely to give a bad name to the school will invite disciplinary action leading to expulsion from the school. Children will be issued yellow card as first warning, green card as second and red card as final warning which will lead to suspension/expulsion. On the advice of the disciplinary committee, the Principal may suspend or expel the student.

IDENTITY CARDS

Identity cards are issued to all pupils. Every identity card is valid for one session only. Every pupil has to carry her/his Identity Card with her/him to school everyday.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

As part of our curriculum, different kinds of activities like debates, speech competitions, quizzes, sports and games, art & craft, handwork, cooking and baking, fancy dress competitions etc. are held regularly in all the sections of the school.

GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING

Expert & trained counsellors are available to address the personal, social, behavioural, emotional and academic issues of the students and to help them set appropriate career goals.

MEDICAL AID

1. Parents must inform the school if their ward is suffering from any chronic disease like asthma, epilepsy, diabetes, and rheumatic heart disease etc. along with the name of medicines prescribed by a certified doctor.
2. First Aid is administered to the students in the school in case of emergency, after which if required the student maybe taken to the hospital by the parents' consent.

AWARDS & ACCOLADES

1. Proficiency, regularity and academic excellence awards are given to meritorious students.
2. The students are also awarded in different competitions and sports events which are held from time to time to develop in them various skills and enhance participation.

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS AND VISITS

Excursions and trips to various places within the city and outside are organized to allow the students to explore the real world around them and broaden their perspectives and to offer a multidimensional learning experience.

FEE PAYMENT

1. Fee will be charged in **4** installments for class **P.G to XII** and in **3** installments for class **XI**.
2. School fee and other charges are to be paid according to the Fee Card latest by the 20th of the first month of the quarter in which installment is due. **It is compulsory to pay the school fees WITHIN THE FIRST MONTH OF THE QUARTER.**

1st Quarterly fee → April -May → Must be paid by April 20th

2nd Quarterly fee → July, August, September → Must be paid by July 20th

3rd Quarterly fee → October, November, December → Must be paid by October 20th

4th Quarterly fee → January, February, March → Must be paid by Jan 20th

3. Parents / Guardians should pay fees by Cash/ School App. /Swap Machine / QR Code
4. **Direct online bank transfers will not be accepted.**
5. **Late fee of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged effective from the 21st day of the first month of the quarter. Name of the students will be struck off if the fees is not paid till the last day of the month ending quarter. No communication in this regard will be entertained.**
6. School offices will remain open during summer and winter vacations also. Anyone failing to pay the installments of the fees on time will be charged a fine for that period. No request for granting exemption of fine for that period (winter and summer vacations) will be entertained.
7. School fee and admission charges will not be refunded if a student is withdrawn / expelled from the school anytime during the session.
8. The fee card must be brought along with the fees.
9. Non-Payment of fee may debar a child from appearing in the examination. Report Card and Transfer Certificate will not be issued until all dues are cleared.
10. If the fee card is lost, it can be re-issued on payment of **Rs. 100/-**
11. If desired, the whole fee may be deposited at the beginning of the session.
12. **No request to waive the fine will be entertained.**

Rules of fee payment for Boarders

1. **1st installment** of hostel fee should be paid by **20th April** and **2nd installment** by **20th October** (for old students).
2. For new admissions **1st installment** should be paid at the time of admission.
3. Late fine of **Rs. 10/-** will be charged effective from the 21st day of the month in which installment is due.
4. **Hostel Fee for the whole session will be charged irrespective of the time of admission in the school / joining of the hostel / number of days stayed in the hostel.**
5. The fee card must be brought along with the fees.
6. If the fee card is lost, It can be re-issued on payment of **Rs. 100/-**

PROCEDURE FOR WITHDRAWAL

Three months advance notice in writing or three months fee in lieu of such a notice is needed for withdrawal of a student from the school. School leaving certificate will be issued on payment of ₹ 200/-. A fine of ₹ 250/- will be charged for a duplicate. Character Certificate and Date of Birth Certificate will be issued on payment of ₹ 100/- each. A Duplicate Result will be issued only on payment of ₹ 300/-. Parents are required to apply at least a week in advance for Transfer Certificate or any other document.

TERMINATION

This may be effective on any one of the following grounds and the decision of the school will be final and binding on the student concerned.

- Continuous long absence without prior sanctioned leave.
- Behaviourial traits of the student detrimental to the school/class/fellow school mates.
- Non-payment of fee or a chronic irregularity in payment as per schedule.
- Persistent negligence of school programmes by the students/parents.
- Disrespect by parents/guardians to the teaching and/or non-teaching staff.

Note : Minimum 75% attendance is compulsory for all students to appear in the final Evaluation/Examination held at the end of the academic year. Cases of shortage of attendance will be considered as per CBSE rules.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- Guidelines are formulated keeping in view the utmost welfare of the students and the smooth functioning of the school. Therefore please read the contents of this Almanac carefully and also advise your ward about the rules laid down by the school authorities.
- Students are expected to join school on the notified date at the beginning of the session and after vacations.
- Kindly ensure that your ward wears prescribed school uniform and shoes, looks neat, tidy and well groomed.
- Please see that your ward carries text/exercise books according to the time table for the day. The almanac should be brought to school daily.
- Please go through the teacher's remarks in his/her class work/homework exercise book and school almanac daily and take proper action.
- You can meet the teachers with prior appointment to discuss your ward's progress besides scheduled parent-teacher meetings. Meeting with teachers is not allowed during school hours. In case of any urgent matter, parents can meet teachers in the stay-back period after school.
- Encourage your ward to take keen interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports for an all round development of personality.
- On being called by any school authority the Parents/Guardian should make it a point to visit the school and meet the relevant person.
- If your ward is absent from school, ensure that the work missed during the period of absence is completed at the earliest.
- No child will be allowed to leave the premises before the school is over. You are requested not to make any social or medical appointment during school hours.
- Refrain from giving regular pocket money to your ward. Encourage healthy eating habits, especially a healthy breakfast and give home cooked food in the

tiffin. Regulate their sleeping hours. At least 8 hours sleep is essential for healthy growth and development.

- Sick students should not be sent to school. Short leave is not permissible as it hampers the school proceedings.
- Parents must inform the school, if their ward is having any chronic disease along with the treatment and the name of medicines prescribed by the doctor.
- No application for changing of section on parents request shall be acknowledged. The school administration's decision will be final.
- Parent's attention is drawn to the fact that criticism of the teachers and of the school in presence of a child should be compulsorily avoided because it causes the student to lose respect for their teachers.
- Presenting any sort of gift item to any staff, student or any other member of school is prohibited even on special occasions.
- Students are not allowed to bring expensive belongings to schools, parents must ensure not to send expensive or luxury items in the form of watches, bags, water bottles and pencil cases etc.
- Kindly ensure that your ward attends school regularly and is punctual in the morning to attend the school assembly.
- As the medium of instruction is English, children should be encouraged by having conversation in this language at home.
- Messages must be checked on school Whatsapp Groups regularly/daily for which it is crucial for parents to **provide a valid/working phone number to the school.**

- **Parents are requested to maintain close contact with the school through the Almanac attend all the P.T.Ms/ Orientation Meetings/school functions and take keen interest in the overall development of your ward.**

STUDENTS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM BRINGING MOBILE PHONES. IF FOUND, IT WILL BE CONFISCATED AND NOT RETURNED.



- Kindly ensure that your ward does not carry any electronic gadget such as mobile phone, camera, iPad, laptop, smart watch, pen-drive etc. to the school. Possession of such items by the students in the school will be treated as an offence.

MOBILE PHONES WILL BE CONFISCATED AND NOT RETURNED.

Repeated offence will lead to firm action by the school authorities.

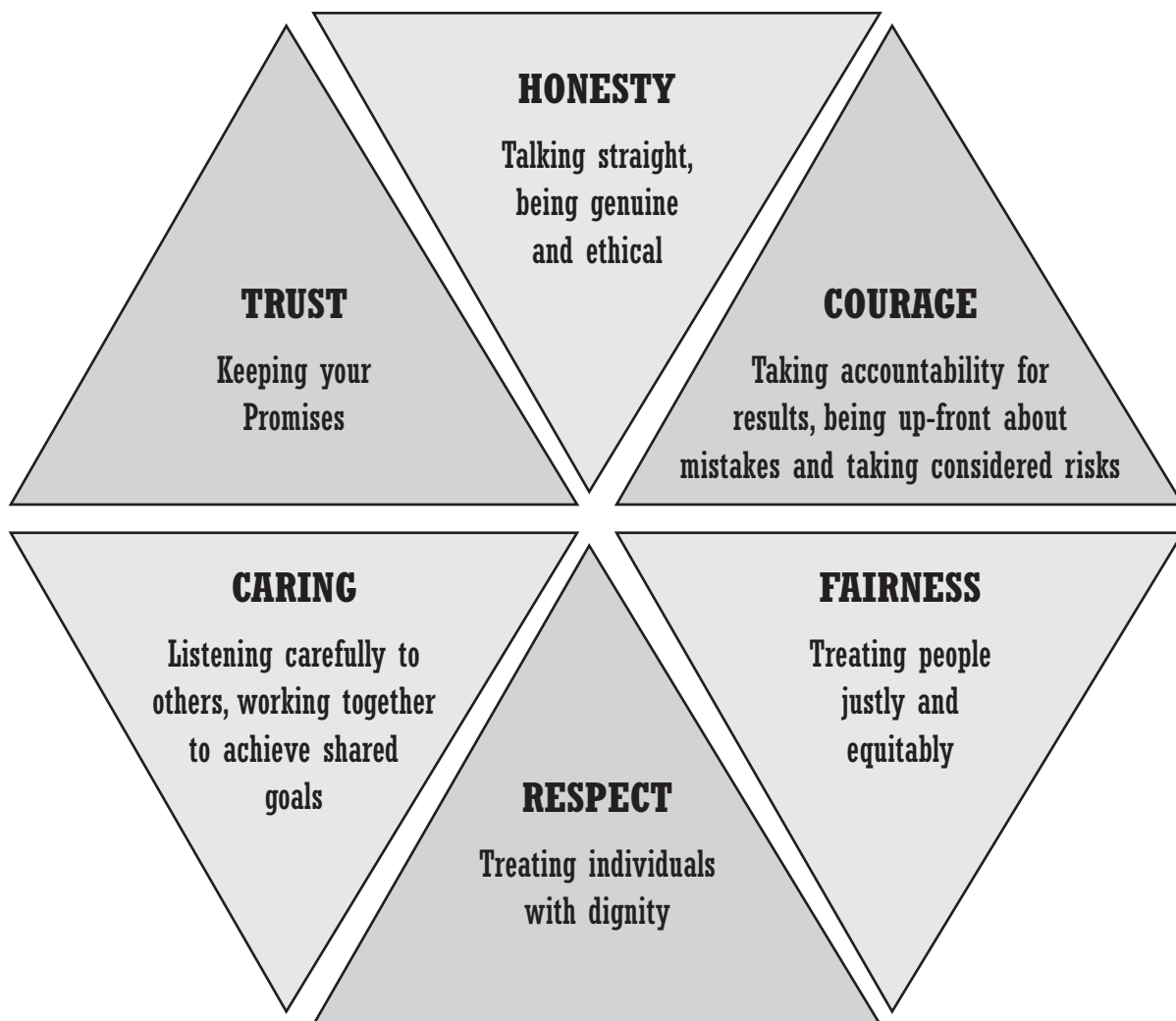
